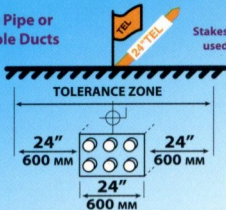

TOLERANCE ZONE

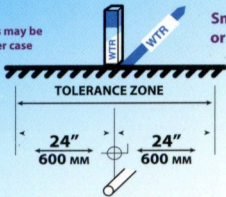
Large Pipe or

Any excavation within the tolerance zone shall be performed with hand tools until the marked facility is exposed. According to New York State law, 16 NYCRR Part 753, the width of the tolerance zone is 24" (600 mm) from each side of the facility. The tolerance zone includes the width of the facility and 24" (600 mm) measured from each side of the facility.
